SUBJECT: Request to review the programme of study “BSc (Hons) International Hospitality Management”, which is offered by the Alexander College (Paphos), via the franchise method, in collaboration with the Canterbury Christ Church University, UK.

I have instructions to refer to the above subject in response to your letter, dated on November 14th, 2024.

The final review/assessment of the programme of study **BSc (Hons) International Hospitality Management (3 Academic Years, 180 ECTS)**, has been completed in compliance with CYQAA’s Law [N. 136 (I) / 2015 to 35 (I) 2021], article 11].

Therefore, Alexander College (Paphos) is permitted to offer the above mentioned higher education qualification of the Canterbury Christ Church University, UK, via the franchise method.

It must be taken into consideration for your reviews, that CYQAA requires from all higher education institutions offering bachelor and postgraduate degrees, to comply with the academic/teaching staff regulation, so that the institution’s part time teaching staff does not exceed 30% of the total teaching and research staff of the School.

Furthermore, the institution should provide to the Agency the ERGANI payment documentations for **all** academic staff who teach in the programme and upload **all** academic staff profiles (name and rank) on the institutions’s website. Additionally, you are informed that, on the basis of the Article 17(3)(g), in case of no compliance with the Agency’s recommendations, permission to run the above franchise programme will be terminated, and your students will be asked to move to another institution.

The current review commences in the fall semester of the academic year 2024-2025 and ceases to be in effect at the end of the spring semester of the academic year 2028-2029.
