- **Improving information management.**

EUC’s student information system (SIS), is a management information system for education sector establishments used to manage student data and has been recently redesigned so as to integrate students, academic staff and the administration information flow in a more efficient, effective and responsive way. Student information systems provide capabilities for registering students in courses; documenting grading, transcripts of academic achievement and co-curricular activities, and the results of student assessment scores; forming student schedules; tracking student attendance; generating reports and managing other student-related data needs



in an educational institution. In general, it records the students' journey from the time of admission till graduation and then as alumni.
