Philology/ language. This specific section aims at teaching the second of the classical languages (Ancient Greek and Latin), which was not selected as Subject I. In case the student is competent in both languages, he can choose specialization subjects in these languages and the relevant texts, or courses in other ancient languages.

Methodology. This section aims at widening students' knowledge in specific techniques and methods applied in the treatment of the primary material of each subject area (for example, text edition, archaeological documentation, etc.), including disciplines such as Epigraphy, Papyrology, Numismatics, Palaeography and others.

Specialization subjects. Courses which specialize or apply the knowledge attained in the course of the study of the basic subjects. Therefore, these subjects broaden the research perspective and offer a synthetical overview of the scientific issues. Additionally, the subjects offer the chance to engage with adjacent subject areas (Historical Linguistics, Anatolian Studies, Byzantine Studies, etc.)
