<sup>\*\*</sup> In Semester 8, students rotate through the following clinical attachments: Primary Care, Internal Medicine and General Surgery. In addition to core clinical activity, ward-based teaching, and opportunities for self-directed learning, clinical attachments are combined with taught sessions, mostly at the outset of the semester, to provide students with introductory lectures and clinical and communication skills teaching sessions. This enables them to build on prior knowledge and maximize their time spent in the clinical environment.

<sup>\*\*\*</sup> Years 5 and 6 are full-time clinical years, where students rotate through clinical attachments. Teaching within these attachments consists of core clinical activity, ward-based teaching and additional learning opportunities for self-directed learning. Clinical attachments are combined with taught sessions, including introductory lectures, seminars and webinars, enabling them to maximise their time spent in the clinical environment.
